2009 Winderlea Chardonnay

Floral aromas of honeysuckle, hyacinth, apple and peach. Rich pear and slight honey tones with bright acidity on the palate ending with a full and lush finish.

Dark black cherries, anise and cedar spice nose. Rich black and notes of bright red fruit punctuated with strawberry, currants and a hint of orange zest on the palate. A very pretty glass of wine.

Violets, sarsaparilla and a hint of cedar spice on the nose. Red fruit on entry leading to darker fruit, black cherry, citrus peel, root beer and a touch of earthiness on palate. Silky and elegant finish.
